5. Declarations of Interest

6. To discuss placement of bollards at Roffey Corner

Members are advised that a local resident has made a request via West Sussex County Council for the row of bollards to be extended slightly beyond the street light column, as it appears that some verge parking is still taking place in the thin strip of grass in this location causing it to become torn up.

If any additional bollards need to be purchased, they are currently priced at £100.94+VAT with the reflective banding costing £8.65+VAT, plus any labour charges for installation.
