7. Declarations of Interest

8. To consider proposed Traffic Regulation Order on sections of Rusper Road and sections of Jackdaw Lane

West Sussex County Council are consulting on a proposed permanent Traffic Regulation Order. The Order will introduce lengths of prohibition of waiting at all times (double yellow lines) on sections of both sides of Rusper Road in the vicinity of its junctions with The Hollies, Little Hatch and Littlehaven Lane and, on sections of the western side of Jackdaw Lane opposite the junctions with Swallowtail Road, Red Admiral Street, Siskin Close and Serrin Way.

Detailed maps showing the proposed changes will be available at the meeting.
