11. Holbrook Tythe Barn Security Measures

Following a third incidence of travellers camped out on the car park at Holbrook Tythe Barn since November, members are asked to consider installing preventative measures to try and prevent a further occurrence.

See Appendix B for various options and costs.

Recommendation: To consider installing security measures, including a height barrier at the entrance to the car park at Holbrook Tythe Barn to try to prevent further incidents of trespass.

12. Holbrook Tythe Barn – Installation of hand rail

At the meeting of the Property Committee in June last year it was agreed, following a request from the Multiple Sclerosis Society who use the Tythe Barn every week, to have steel handrails fitted along the front and the side of the slope leading to the front door. The chosen contractor was unable to do the work and since then we have tried to obtain quotes from other sources.

Despite approaching several companies, we have only received quotes from one contractor which are as follows:

Supply galvanized scaffold style handrail and install £650

Supply FibreRail handrail and install

£750

FibreRail can be supplied in either yellow or grey and is not cold to touch unlike the steel. The lead time for the FibreRail may be as long as 10 weeks.

Recommendation: To AGREE to fit DDA compliant handrails at the front entrance to Holbrook Tythe Barn.

13. Tree Works at Earles Meadow (deferred from previous meeting)

See Appendix C

A resident has reported that an Oak Tree on Earles Meadow is blocking out light to part of his property. Following a ground inspection, a tree surgeon has reported that the tree looks safe and has no obvious defects. The tree has been reduced previously and does overhang the property in question.

Quotes have been obtained for the following work:

- A. To prune back overhang by approx. 1 2 m from property £330
- B. To carry out a full crown reduction by approx. 2m leaving a natural and balanced crown £660.

Recommendation:

To consider undertaking work to the Oak tree at Earles Meadow.

14. Earles Meadow - Boardwalks

The Earles Meadow Conservation Group (EMCG) has carried out an inspection of the boardwalks and identified problems with some of them. Some of these they can fix themselves. The cost of 10 boards for the EMCG to repair the boards that they are able to is approximately £60.

Some of the boards need to be repaired professionally and from previous experience trying to find a contractor that can carry out this work is very difficult.

We have approached the contractor we have used previously for this type of work and who carries out similar work for HDC and are waiting for a quote which will be circulated prior to the meeting.

Recommendations:

- (i) To AGREE to purchase boards at an approved cost so that the EMCG can carry out running repairs to the boardwalks
- (ii) To AGREE to appoint a contractor to carry out the more complicated repairs at a cost to be agreed.

15. Internal Decorating at all Venues

See Appendix D

We have a schedule for decorating the internal areas of all of our halls. This works on a 3 year rolling basis to ensure that all public areas are kept smart and clean. The areas due to be decorated this summer are shown in Appendix D together with the various quotes that have been obtained.

Recommendations:

- (i) To AGREE to decorate the Barn at Holbrook Tythe Barn
- (ii) To AGREE to decorate North and South Halls at Roffey Millennium Hall
- (iii) To AGREE to decorate rooms 1 and 4 at North Heath Hall.

16. Roof - Roffey Millennium Hall

Parts of the roof of Roffey Millennium Hall have been damaged in the last few weeks and some remedial work is required. The police have been involved and are of the opinion that it was probably the work of teenagers.

The insurance company has been informed.

Several companies were approached to give a quote but only two replied.

Their quotes can be found in Appendix E.

Recommendation: To AGREE to appoint a company to carry out repair work to the roof at Roffey Millennium Hall.
