#### Income

Guidance from the Health and Safety Executive and encouragement for caution from the government to stop the spread of Coronavirus, means that hirers have to provide risk assessments and insurance cover resulting in fewer hires and a reduction of around £20,000 in income.

## **Expenditure**

Significant savings have been made in all cost centres, especially personnel resulting in a saving of around £52,000.

#### Reserves

On 31<sup>st</sup> July 2021 the General Reserve stood at £291,260 and there were Ear Marked Reserves of £235,449.

#### Summary

There is approximately £20,000 less income than budgeted for in the first third of 2021/22, but this is offset by £52,000 less expenditure. The overall position is that the Council has spent about £32,000 less than anticipated at this time of the financial year. There is adequate reserves to cover 6 months running costs.

Recommendation:-To note the Financial Report to 31st July 2021.
